Axing of local bus service The Clerk reported receiving a number of complaints regarding the removal of an early morning bus service that is used by commuters and Brockenhurst College pupils from Calbourne and Shalfleet Parish. Cllr Dyer indicated his awareness of the problem.

Street furniture maintenance Mr Whitney advised the completion of the three yearly street furniture maintenance programme by contractors.

150/09-10 TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING

The following applications were considered and recommendations made:

P/01119/09 Little Kleffens Main Road Bouldnor-demolition of existing rear extension and rebuilding at ground level with partial extension at 1st floor. **NB** having given prior notice under SO 15 the applicant delivered a short presentation.-***Shalfleet Parish Council has no objection.***

P/01070/09 Northlands Main Road, Newbridge –demolition of kitchen,utility room and store, construction of 1 & 2 storey extension **NB** this application was considered in conjunction with the contents of an email from near neighbours expressing concerns regarding scale and erosion of privacy. ***Shalfleet Parish Council has no objection.***

P/00952/09 Sixpenny Cottage Wellow Top Road-replace existing concrete garage with timber framed garage-*Shalfleet Parish Council has no objection.*

Two addition planning issues were noted and 5 planning application results received.

Cllr Stuart Dyer CC – Cllr Dyer delivered his IWC Ward Councillors report, a copy of which is appended to and forms part of these minutes.

Cllr Burt- heavily overgrown hedge bordering the highway at Downsview Wellow.

Cllr Carr-reported continued concern regarding yellow line provision at Wellow Top Road and requested the subject be placed on the next agenda. Mr Carr also mentioned continued problems regarding the traffic lights and associated traffic regime at Shalfleet. and a recent questionnaire regarding statutory site provision for travellers and other itinerant people.

The Vice Chairman- reported problems being experienced by Island farmers regarding the disposal of dead animal carcasses.

Cllr. Runnete- expressed her concern regarding the current IWC regime covering removal of road diversion signs, she felt that these signs are often left up beyond the official road closure Published dates.
