



#### SHALFLEET PARISH COUNCIL

#### POLICY DOCUMENT FOR THE ERECTION OF PUBLIC USE BENCHES/SEATS

# **A – SPECIFICATION:**

- 1. The specification for any bench/seat is to be to the approval of Shalfleet Parish Council, if sited on property owned or managed by the Parish Council.
- 2. The specification for any bench/seat where sited on land owned or managed by any other agency/organisation must have the approval of that agency/organisation and Shalfleet Parish Council.
- 3. The specification of any seat/bench must have regards to the following:
  - a) The need.
  - b) The purpose.
  - c) The location.
  - d) The size.
  - e) The cost of maintenance.
  - f) The anticipated lifespan.

# **B-LOCATION:**

- 1. The location of any bench/seat is to be agreed by Shalfleet Parish Council and any agency/organisation which controls the land on which the seat/bench is to be sited.
- 2. No seat/bench to be so sited as to cause any obstruction to pedestrians or traffic.

## **C – ERECTION:**

- 1. All seats are to be erected on concrete, tarmacadam or approved hard surfacing.
- 2. Where seats are to be erected on virgin/natural ground they are to be sited on a concrete base as follows:
  - a) Concrete base to be a minimum of 100mm thickness of C20 mix concrete reinforced midway with A142 fabric on 50mm MOT type 1 50 mm blinding.
  - b) Concrete base to be set NLT 25mm above corresponding ground level and laid to falls.
  - c) Concrete to receive a fine tamped and brushed finish and to have margined and arissed edges.
  - d) Concrete base to be the footprint size of the bench/seat plus 150mm on three sides with an extended platform fronting the front edge of the seat/bench of a minimum of 750mm projection.
  - e) All seats/benches are to be secured mechanically to the hard-standing with non-ferrous fixings as agreed by Shalfleet Parish Council.

### **D- DONATION IN PART OF IN WHOLE:**

- 1. Members of the public or any commercial/private interest or agency can request the siting of a seat/bench whereby they can donate the seat/bench as set out in items D2, D3 and D4 below.
- 2. Shalfleet Parish Council will give consideration to any request for a seat/bench. This must be paid for in advance of any orders being placed for the seat/bench by the Parish Council by way of the submission of a pro-forma invoice.
- 3. Shalfleet Parish Council's policy for seats/benches to be provided, as set out in item D2, is that any individual or organisation wishing to have a seat/bench provided will be required to pay the cost of the seat and installation including VAT.
- 4. Where the seats/benches are to be sited on land owned or under the control of Shalfleet Parish Council, the Council will undertake the full commissioning of the seat/bench. The Council will undertake the upkeep of any seat/bench inclusive of all fixtures, fittings and base support for a period of 10 years from the time of full commissioning.
- 5. Shalfleet Parish Council will not be able to take on seating requests on none Parish Council land.

### **E – DEDICATION AND/OR ENGRAVING:**

- 1. Seats/benches may be dedicated by means of an inscribed plaque or in the case of a Reformed Plastic seat, by engraving.
- 2. Any inscription to be first approved by the Parish Council.
- 3. All dedication plaques are to be inset into any wooden mounts and set flush with same.
- 4. All plaques to be in 3 mm engraved solid brass or 2mm grade 316 stainless steel fixed with anti-vandal screws of like material.

#### F - INSURANCE

- 1. All benches/seats must be included in the Parish Council's Register of assets and insurers notified of such additional items.
- 2. Insurance to be maintained against loss or damage throughout the life of the seat/bench where such are included on the register of insured items.
